



Our spring exhibition is rather special this year. I'll be co-curating with Hannah Quigley, an eighthgrade student at Peconic Community School. For her school capstone project, Hannah chose to curate an exhibition on feminist art. I'm thrilled that she brought this urgent topic to us here at the library, where we'll host her show.

Passing the Brush: Feminist Art NOW (3/28 - 5/11) features artworks by several established artists as well as works by younger, emerging artists. The title reflects a central theme of the exhibition, which highlights the power and possibilities of women and girls supporting, and learning from, each other.

As part of the exhibition, we're delighted to partner with Vanessa Marr of the **Domestic Dusters Project**. This craftivist enterprise invites women and girls to embroider their views of so-called "women's work" on a yellow duster. If you'd like to contribute, please pick a \*free\* duster and embroidery pack at the library, though supplies are limited.
