Thank you to the Peconic Landing Lifetime Learning Program for their generous donation supporting the early literacy initiative through the Dolly Parton Imagination Library. The Dolly Parton Imagination Library supplies the books and the Friends pay for the postage so that children receive the books at home. Fifty-five of the youngest members of the Floyd Memorial Library are enrolled and receive a free book each month. We have "graduated" 10 children who have turned 5 years of age and are always looking for more children under the age of 5 to participate. Applications can be found in the Children's Room at the library.

We will be cleaning out the Book Nook in the basement in May and June in order for the library to utilize the space. We will still sell a limited number of books on a dedicated shelf upstairs. If you are interested in donating books, we will take any best sellers that were published within the last five years. The money raised will directly benefit the library.






Contact the circulation desk to make a 30 minute appointment with **Ian**, our **Library Technology Specialist**.
