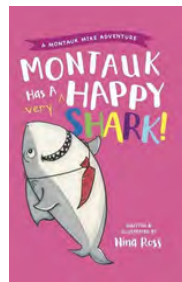

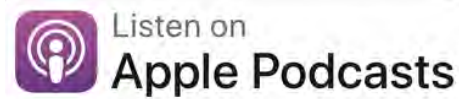

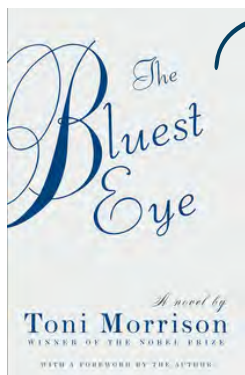

NOTES FROM THE CURATOR

Thank you to everyone who joined us for the opening reception of **Stow Wengenroth + The Flacks: The Greenport Group**. But don't worry if you missed it; you have until **June 14** to catch this very special exhibition.

The lithographs of **Stow Wengenroth** (1906–1978) are in the permanent collections of many of America's major museums, including the NGA, the Smithsonian, the Met and MoMA. Not only is this a rare opportunity to view his works here in Greenport, but all of the pieces on display from the private **Joanna Lane Collection** are in mediums *other* than lithography, including masterful drawings of Greenport and Paris, and evocative watercolors and oils of Maine.

Wengenroth's works are joined by those of his Greenport artistic allies, his wife, the doll and marionette maker **Edith Flack Ackley** (1887–1970), and her sister, children's storybook writer and illustrator **Marjorie Flack** (1897–1958). Also on view are two new marionettes, created in dialogue with Ackley's models, by contemporary puppet maker **Carmen Campos**.

Finally, save the date for the opening reception of our large group summer show on **June 26, 5–7 pm**. Tying in with America's 250th anniversary, **A Portrait of America** features documentary photography that reflects on various aspects of the country—the good, the bad and the ugly.
