

Poppy Johnson, who had been our children's librarian since 1986, decided she wanted a change. Joe then became our full time children's librarian, trading places with Poppy, who has been our full time reference, adult services and program librarian since then.

Joe reached out into the community, bringing programs to the local schools and daycares as well as welcoming them into the library. He developed the 4EC- a cooperative group of libraries, schools, parent organizations for East End education enrichment shortly after taking on the children's program. He's been a valuable member of our staff and the larger community. We will miss him and wish him well in his retirement.
